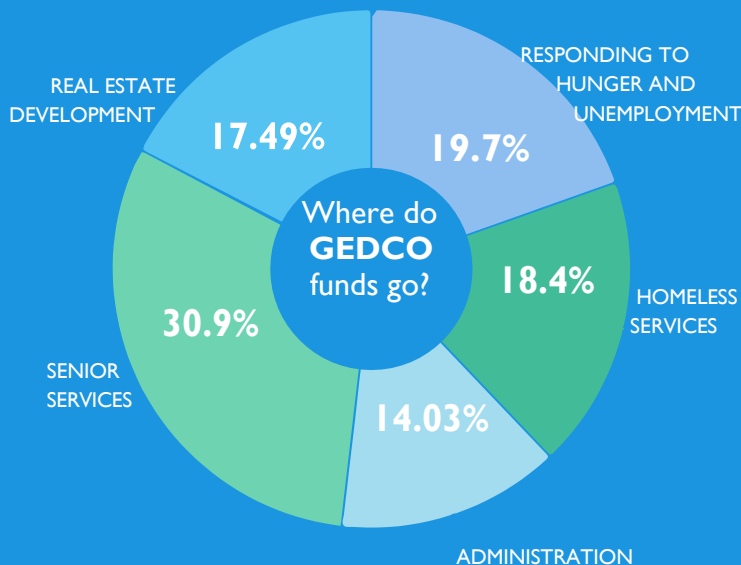
Established in 1991, GEDCO's programs are a model for the State of Maryland in **servicing low income individuals and families.**

OUR IMPACT

In 2016, GEDCO:

Gave **530** individuals a home through our affordable housing services

Responded to over **3,977 requests** for food and provided financial assistance to **761 households** through our CARES program

Served over **3,647** people, which included **1,565** families at our Northeast Food Pantry

Help **118 individuals** find jobs through our CARES Career Connection job counseling program
